






4 countries – 1 lake

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Gardens and Palaces

Lake Constance gardens present it just like a gigantic horticultural show which takes visitors on a journey through time:

- The **Island of Mainau** is known as the island of flowers
- The monastic **Island of Reichenau** is where Europe's first guidebook on gardening was written
- Carthusian Monastery Ittingen: hosts Switzerland's most expansive historical rose collection turning it into a delightful sea of flowers
- Salem Monastery/Palace: in-midst abundant parks is Salem's Palace, venue of great events

All four countries boast fascinating events

- The **Bregenz Festival** (A): famous opera performed on the world's largest stage on a lake
- 'Princely week' (FL): memorable hikes, wine tastings and bustling fair with fireworks show
- Fifth season: with **Fasnacht** (Carnival) winter is driven out in the 4 countries
- Kulturufer Friedrichshafen (D) culture festival at the lakeshore in Friedrichshafen
- Festival of Sand Sculptures in Rorschach (CH)
- Advent season and **Christmas markets**: some of the most memorable are in St. Gall (CH), Lindau (D) and Constance (D)

- and many other attractions around the Lake





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
Easy Access

The easiest access to Lake Constance is by plane via the following airports:


- Bodensee-Airport Friedrichshafen (D)


